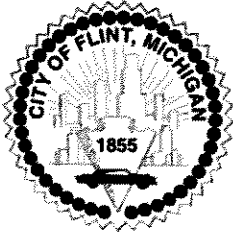

**RESOLUTION TO RESPOND TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH IMPACTS OF THE PANDEMIC THROUGH
THE CONTINUED WORK OF THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC HEALTH**

BY THE MAYOR:

WHEREAS, the City of Flint is a duly created and validly existing political subdivision of the State of Michigan under the Constitution and laws of the state of Michigan, and;

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the President of the United States of America signed into law the “American Rescue Plan Act of 2021”, also known as House Resolution 1319, an Act approved by the Congress of the United States, and which authorized the Treasury of the United States to disburse certain funds to local governments, including the City of Flint, which could be used for specific and defined purposes, and;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, the City of Flint wishes to exercise its right to extend and disseminate assistance to impacted households tied to specific criteria, as authorized by the Act, to assist citizens who may have been impacted financially by the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic.

WHEREAS, the administration recommends funding up to \$121,249.25 for the City of Flint’s Office of Public Health to continue providing needed access to public health resources, direct navigation for city residents to many community resources on a case-by-case basis, continuance of lead mitigation services including distribution of water filtration systems, conducting the distribution of test kits for Lead and Copper Rule testing, and expanding their scope of work to include public health initiatives that focus on equity, environmental justice, food policy mental health, substance abuse, and more.

IT IS RESOLVED that the appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary to provide funding to operate the Office of Public Health, amend the FY23 budget, and appropriate funding for revenue and expenditures in future fiscal years, for as long as funds are available from the funder. Funds will be paid from the American Rescue Plan Act fund (287). Before funds are spent, the City of Flint’s ARPA administration, compliance, and implementation firm shall review and ensure compliance with the latest US Department of Treasury final rules.

Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

The grants that previously funded the Office of Public Health, Healthy Start grant provided to the Genesee County Health Department from the Health Resources and Services Administration, an agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services; and Flint Lead Exposure Registry at Michigan State University, have ended, and the office has become an essential part of public health services and referrals for the City of Flint. The Office of Public Health is often the first point of contact for residents in crisis, and the Information Desk is the first point of contact for visitors to City Hall, and includes the only person on city staff who is fluent in Spanish.

The Office of Public Health provides access to public health resources, direct navigation for city residents to many community resources on a case-by-case basis, continuance of lead mitigation services including distribution of water filtration systems, conducting the distribution of test kits for Lead and Copper Rule testing, with plans to expand their scope of work to include public health initiatives that focus on equity, environmental justice, food policy, mental health, substance abuse, and more, in continued partnership with community based organizations and the Genesee County Health Department.

This would fund operations for the Office of Public Health for one year, with the expectation that additional grant funding would be secured for office ongoing sustainability.

This project is included in the Mayor's American Rescue Plan Act Recovery Plan, presented to Council on June 14, 2022.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FLINT TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR
AUDITING SERVICES WITH REHMANN ROBSON, LLC FOR THE FY2022 AUDIT**

BY THE CITY COUNCIL:

On June 22, 2020, Flint City Council adopted Resolution No. 200258 to enter into a three-year agreement with Rehmann Robson, LLC for a total contract amount of \$701,000.00 to conduct the FY 2020 audit at a cost of \$225,000.00 for FY2020, \$233,500 for FY2021, and \$242,500.00 for FY2022, for a total contract amount of \$701,000.00; and

On November 23, 2020, Flint City Council adopted Resolution No. 200479 authorizing an additional \$7,500.00 in spending to cover single audit services, for a total aggregate three-year amount of \$708,500; and

Last year Rehmann Robson, LLC submitted an engagement letter to perform the City of Flint annual audit for FY2021 for \$236,000.00, which represented an increase of \$2,500.00 to present the city's financial statement in conformity with the Government Financial Officers Association criteria, plus out-of-pocket expenses; and

This year's cost for the audit is \$242,500.00 as outlined in the original agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the appropriate city officials are authorized to do all things necessary to engage the services of Rehmann Robson, LLC for FY2022 auditing services, for the amount of \$242,500.00, for a total contract price of \$711,000.00, plus out-of-pocket expenses. Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

Starr Surplus Lines Insurance Company currently provides the City with its High-Valued Vehicle and Contractor's Equipment insurance coverage. The current policy expires on 12/25/2022.

Through the City's insurance broker, the Lighthouse Group solicited bids. Of the six companies to respond, four declined to quote, and two declined to quote.

- Travelers – Not a market for High Valued Vehicles
- Lloyds of London – Quoted higher and coverages not as broad as Starr policy. Missing key coverages
- Scottsdale Ins – Declined, cannot complete with Starr rates
- XL Catlin Ins – Declined, cannot complete with Starr rates
- Chubb Ins – Declined – Not a market for high-valued vehicles

The Starr Lines Insurance Company quote of \$168,861.58 also includes Terrorism coverage in the amount of \$7,845. In addition to being the lowest bidder, Star Lines Insurance Company offers the following advantages:

- Increased coverage at the insured value.
- No maximum limits per vehicle.
- "A" Rated Carrier
- The maximum coverage at any one location for each occurrence would remain the same as our current coverage of \$1,500,000 (flood coverage for flood at any one location, per occurrence, would be \$500,000 less)

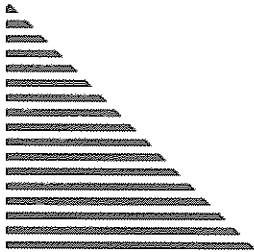
