## **NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE HOME-ARP GRANT PROGRAM THAT WAS RELEASED ON APRIL 13, 2023 AND;**

## **PUBLIC NEEDS HEARING IN THE CITY HALL DOME ON APRIL 16<sup>TH</sup> AT 5:30 PM.**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the city proposes to allocate unspent HOME-ARP Grant program funds. In accordance with 24 CFR (Code of Federal Regulations) Part 91, Subpart B, the city of Flint, is required to amend its Consolidated Plan whenever it makes substantial amendments to the plan as defined in its Citizens Participation Plan. This amendment is considered substantial in that the city proposes to carry out new activities exceeding 15 percent of the federal program grant from which the funding is derived, the HOME-ARP program. The regulations also require that Citizens be afforded the opportunity to provide comments to such changes.

The City of Flint was previously awarded HOME-ARP (American Rescue Plan) Act 2021, to reduce homelessness and increase housing stability. The amendment proposes revising the previously approved budget and allocating unspent HOME-ARP funding for the following activities: Supportive Services, Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA), Affordable Housing, Nonprofit Operating and Capacity Building. Activities will be carried out through the following agencies:
